Background and Summary:

In order to bring awareness to the importance of historic preservation and to encourage and reward those who have taken an active role in preservation, the City of Carbondale Preservation Commission initiated a Historic Preservation Awards Program. Each year members of the community are invited to submit nominations. Any property within the City is eligible and can be nominated in one of the following categories; preservation, restoration, sympathetic addition, or compatible new construction.

The recipient of the 2013 Historic Preservation Award is 700 West Cherry Street owned by D. Gorton and Jane Adams.

The residence located at 700 W. Cherry St. is being recognized in the category of Restoration. The home, built in the 1920's, recently had a complete restoration. The owners have restored the home by returning the exterior and interior of the home to its original character. The care taken with the restoration illustrates the improvements that can be made to a property while helping preserve its historical character.

Recommended Action:

It is recommended that the Council join the Preservation Commission in recognizing these historic buildings and the efforts of the owners in preserving them for future generations.
